Who can be a mentor?

- Adults over 21 years old
- Able to make a one year commitment for 4-6 hours a month
- People in recovery or with a criminal record can mentor, provided they meet certain criteria

What does a Mentor do?

- Cares, listens, respects, and provides individualized support
- Introduces recreation, leisure, and hobbies into the lives of their mentee
- Promotes personal and social growth, models coping skills
