A \$200 scholarship (courtesy of SELCO CU) will be given to the top applicant in each grade category. In addition to the cash grant, each recipient will have their personal essay displayed on a plaque in the Nobel Peace Park for a one year duration.

The Nobel Laureate Peace Park Education Committee will review all applications. Again, only two winners will be chosen, one from each category (Grades 6 thru 8, and 9 thru 12)
