Linda Smart, Monroe Middle School, District 4J Eugene, won for her work with PeaceJam, and Jose Alonso, Sheldon High School District 4J, won for his work with high school students in conflict resolution and multicultural education.

How to submit a Nomination

- Your name and position (contact info.)
- Nominated teacher name, school, and grades taught (contact info.)
- A letter explaining why you are nominating this teacher. (500 words or less)
- Letter of support from Principal or team leader, and 1-2 students or parents

Candidates for *Peace Teacher of the Year* should be exceptionally dedicated, knowledgeable, and skilled educators in grades 3-12 and:

- Inspire students of all backgrounds and abilities in the areas of peace education, conflict resolution, multicultural understanding and/or other relevant topics
- Have the support and admiration of students, parents, and colleagues
- Play an active role in the community as well

Award

In addition to a \$200 cash grant, the award recipient will be acknowledged on a plaque which will be displayed in the Nobel Peace Park for a one year duration.

Selection Process

The Nobel Laureate Peace Park Education Committee will review all applications and select the winner.
